College Bound Scholarship



Yes, you can afford college!

This state-funded scholarship covers tuition for up to 4 years at a Washington college or university.

Students are automatically enrolled if they are either:

(1) in public school and eligible for free/reduced price lunch in 7th, 8th, or 9th grade,

OR, (2) in state foster care or a dependent of the state between 7th grade and high school graduation.

Maintenance Updates

 The KCHA Maintenace team is making parking and access improvements at several communities, including: Ballinger Homes, Bellevue House Three, Birch Creek, Campus Court II, Cedar Grove I II & III, Cascade Homes, Eastridge House, Forest Glen, Forest Grove, Glenview Heights, Greenleaf, Hillsview, Houghton, Patricia Harris, Plaza Seventeen, Shoreham, Spiritwood, Vantage Point, and Valli Kee.

- To keep our communities vibrant and inviting, we are refreshing some building exteriors with **new paint**, including at Seola Gardens and Riverton Family. Please mind the signs and keep an eye out for wet paint.
- Look for upgrades in laundry rooms and offices across King County to better serve you. Some of these improvements include an office remodel at Greenleaf, an improved laundry space for Westminster, and a new kitchen space in the community room for Mardi Gras. More to come!
- Older **fire alarm systems** are being upgraded at 25 properties. The upgrade switches the fire communication system from telephone lines to radio to improve reliability and safety.

Security Updates

- A FAQ about KCHA's security contractor, **Allied Universal**, was distributed to Property Management and Resident Services teams to post at housing communities.
- **New security cameras** are being installed at Cascade Homes and Valli Kee. Seven more properties, including Ballinger Homes, Birch Creek, Briarwood, Burndale Homes, Firwood Circle, Mardi Gras, and Riverton Terrace are scheduled for new security cameras by the end of 2024.
- 12 mobile security trailers have been deployed to provide extra lighting and security camera coverage when and where it is needed.
- New key card readers will be installed for additional security in accessing laundry rooms and community rooms.
